11. Planning – i) Application 20/0029/FUL

I spoke with the Case Officer for the application 19.05.2020, he was aware of the letter received back from the Minister following the letter sent by Dr Caroline Johnson. Due to Coronavirus although we are passed the deadline of 22nd April 2020 for comments from the members of the public the case officer is still accepting comments should members of the public still wish to do so. I have posted this information on both the website and facebook.

Responses received from consultations are being reviewed; together with the plans and supporting documents submitted as part of the application to see if there is any additional information or amendments required. There is a major increase in the housing against the indicative figure of 276 in the Local Plan; which is driven by the number of small units on the plans – is this an appropriate mix.

The Case Officer is in consultation with Highways concerning the impact on the highway and drainage. Concerns regarding the application are being relayed to the developer, at this stage it is unknown if the developer will submit amended plans or decide to pursue the existing plans already submitted; before going to the Planning Committee.

Should amended plans be submitted there would be a further consultation period with an opportunity for both the members of the public and the Parish Council to comment.
